The **European Society for Comparative Endocrinology (ESCE)** aims to promote advancement of basic and applied research in all aspects of comparative endocrinology by disseminating important results of this research field among scientists. To foster interdisciplinary communication, the Conference of the European Society for Comparative Endocrinology (CECE) is organized biennially providing an environment for the exchange of ideas during scheduled scientific sessions, presentations as well as during informal gatherings. The forthcoming meeting in 2010 is the 25th in the row, which will be held in the University of Pécs (Hungary).



The University of Pécs was founded in 1367. It is not only the oldest but, with over 40 thousand students, also the largest university in Hungary. The conference is to be housed by the Medical School. The School has very wealthy, internationally recognized scientific activity in many branches of the biomedical sciences.
